## **2. Product Overview**

Model Name: Dead Fiat Bitcoin Watch

Movement: Seiko NH35A automatic with 24 jewels for reduced friction and enhanced durability

### **3. Warranty & Customer Support**

#### **a. Warranty Coverage**

Your Dead Fiat Bitcoin Watch is covered by the minimum legal warranty applicable in your country of residence, which protects you as a consumer in case of manufacturing defects.

Examples include:

- European Union: 2-year statutory warranty under EU Consumer Law
- United States: Minimum of 1 year (state laws may vary)

This legal warranty ensures that your watch will be free from manufacturing defects in materials and workmanship at the time of purchase.

Important: This warranty does not cover:

- Normal wear and tear (e.g. scratches, fading, aging of materials)
- Accidental damage, misuse or mishandling
- Water damage caused by improper use (e.g. crown not screwed in)
- Repairs or alterations by unauthorized service providers

## **b. Customer Support & Claims**

To initiate a warranty claim:

  - Full name
  - Purchase receipt or order number
  - Reference number (found on the warranty card or case back)

3. Our team will guide you through the next steps, which may include inspection, repair, or replacement if applicable under your legal warranty.

When contacting our support team (e.g. for warranty claims), you may be asked to provide personal data such as your name, email address, purchase details, and photographs of the product.

We only collect this information to assist you with customer service and warranty processing.

## 4. Using your watch

### a. Setting the Time

1. Unscrew the crown by turning it counterclockwise until it releases and pops out slightly.
2. Gently pull the crown to the second position — the second hand will stop ticking.
3. Rotate the crown clockwise or counterclockwise to adjust the time.
4. After setting the time, push the crown back in and screw it down clockwise to lock it securely. This prevents moisture or dust from entering.

⚠ Never pull the crown straight out without unscrewing it first. Doing so may damage the winding system.



## **b. Starting the Movement**

- This is a self-winding mechanical watch. It winds automatically with the movement of your wrist.
- If the watch has stopped due to inactivity, gently swing it side to side about 10 times.
- The second hand should start moving.
- Set the time and wear it for at least 8 hours per day for optimal performance.
- Manual winding is not necessary under normal usage.

## **c. Adjusting the Metal Bracelet (Screw Link System)**

Your watch features a stainless steel bracelet with removable links secured by small screws. You can adjust the length easily at home with a precision screwdriver.

Tools needed:

- Small flathead screwdriver (typically 1.0–1.4 mm or 3/64"–1/16")
- Optional: link holder or soft cloth to protect the bracelet

Instructions:

1. Identify removable links: Look for the small screws on the side of the bracelet – these indicate adjustable links.

2. Unscrew the pin. Hold the bracelet securely and carefully unscrew the tiny screw on the side of the link by turning counterclockwise.
3. Remove the link: Once the screw is out, the link will come apart. Remove as many links as needed for a comfortable fit. Always remove evenly from both sides of the clasp for best balance.
4. Reattach the bracelet: Line up the remaining links and carefully screw the pin back in, turning clockwise. Make sure the screw is fully seated but do not overtighten.
5. Final check: Try the watch on and ensure it fits snugly but comfortably. You should be able to insert one finger between your wrist and the bracelet.

 Important Tips:

- Work on a clean, well-lit surface to avoid losing screws.
- Do not use excessive force – the screws are delicate.
- If unsure, consult a watchmaker to avoid damage.

#### **d. Manual Winding**

As an alternative to automatic winding, this watch can also be manually wound via the crown.

1. Unscrew the crown by turning it counterclockwise until it releases and pops out slightly.

2. Keep the crown in its normal position (position 0) without pulling it to the next position.
3. Turn the crown clockwise approximately 20 to 30 times. This winds the mainspring and powers the movement. Do not turn the crown counterclockwise.
4. Push the crown back in and screw it down clockwise to lock it securely. This prevents moisture or dust from entering.

## 5. Care Instructions

To ensure your Dead Fiat Bitcoin Watch continues to perform flawlessly:

- Do not try to open the watchcase or dismantle it
- Clean the case and bracelet with a soft cloth regularly
- Avoid exposure to chemicals, solvents, or strong detergents
- Do not expose to extreme temperatures (hot saunas or freezing conditions)
- Please do not make the watch too tight for your arm. It is appropriate if you can still insert one finger between the arm and band

- Avoid heavy impacts or dropping the watch
- Store in a dry place when not in use
- Have it serviced every 3–5 years by a qualified watchmaker

## 6. Legal Information & Compliance

Dead Fiat Bitcoin Watch complies with applicable product safety and consumer protection laws in all regions where it is actively sold.

This product does **not require CE certification** under current European Union regulations, as it contains **no electronic components**. All materials are compliant with **EU REACH** and **RoHS** directives regarding chemical safety and environmental impact.
